2015-2016 NRA Approved 1800 Indoor Pistol Matches

Match Dates: November 13, December 11, 2016 & January 8, February 5, 2017. Please check calendar for actual event time - forthcoming.

Eligibility: Adult competitors must be individual members of the NRA and be prepared to exhibit their membership card. A junior competitor may be an individual member of the NRA or a member of a club affiliated with the NRA.

NRA Membership Number: All competitors must put their NRA Member ID number on their entry card.

Rules: Current NRA Conventional Pistol rules will govern. The Range Safety Officer will explain range procedures prior to the match. Officers, members & participants are available and willing to assist novice shooters gain a better understanding of the finer points of competition. Pistols may be open sight, red dot or scope – shot one-handed.

Equipment: Absolutely NO jacketed ammo. Hearing & Eye protection is required!

Classification: All competitors will be classified according to the NRA Classification System in individual matches and must exhibit their Classification card or Temporary Score Record Book. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master Class if they do not have an Assigned Classification.

Distance: 50 Feet

Targets: B2 (Slow Fire), B3 (Timed or Rapid Fire)

RIMFIRE

20 Shots Slow Fire – 2 Strings of 10 Rounds

20 Shots Timed Fire – 4 Strings of 5 Rounds in 20 Seconds

20 Shots Rapid Fire – 4 Strings of 5 Rounds in 10 Seconds

(National Match Course)

30 Shots – 10 Rounds Slow Fire, 10 Rounds Timed Fire, 10 Rounds Rapid Fire

CENTERFIRE

20 Shots Slow Fire – 2 Strings of 10 Rounds

20 Shots Timed Fire – 4 Strings of 5 Rounds in 20 Seconds

20 Shots Rapid Fire – 4 Strings of 5 Rounds in 10 Seconds

(National Match Course)

30 Shots – 10 Rounds Slow Fire, 10 Rounds Timed Fire, 10 Rounds Rapid Fire

*Entire match may be shot with Rimfire (5% penalty will apply to the Centerfire portion)
